Music DSE Music Network Programme	In view of the small number of students opting for Music, this Network Programme with other schools can help to cater students' diverse needs	Students were able to pass in exams. Students have over 80% attendance throughout the year. Students were considered as potential musicians while more improvement needed to be made in order to obtain a better result.	1 S5 and 2 S6 students who considered music as their career path and were recommended by the music teacher	According to student's musical ability and the potential of obtaining passing mark in this subject without dropping out	From 9/2018 to 8/2019, lessons were held at the host school of the cohort	The S6 student decided to drop out due to academic pressure and change of preference in terms of career path. Therefore, he did not take DSE Music exam. Students in school results were generally good.
