Academic Performance of S6 Students (2016-17)

Our students once again reaped impressive results in the 2017 HKDSE. 94.5% (121) of our students met the basic entrance requirement for admission to publicly-funded undergraduate programmes (33222), well above the territory-wide day school figure (40.8%). A special mention is given to Wong Yuet Hoi (6E), who achieved a top score of $\underline{six} 5^{**}$, and $\underline{two} 5^{*}$. The results of the best 19 performing students with 29 marks or above are as follows:
