Academic Performance of S6 Students (2020-21)

Our students once again reaped impressive results in the 2021 HKDSE. 92.7% (101) of our students met the basic entrance requirement for admission to publicly-funded undergraduate programmes (33222), well above the territory-wide day school figure (42.2%). The results of the best 18 performing students with 27 marks or above (best 5) are as follows:
