## **Academic Performance of S6 Students (2018-19)**

Our students once again reaped impressive results in the 2019 HKDSE. 83.7% (103) of our students met the basic entrance requirement for admission to publicly-funded undergraduate programmes (33222), well above the territory-wide day school figure (42.1%). A special mention is given to Wong Yin Tung (6D), who achieved a top score of <u>five 5\*\*, two 5\* and one 5</u>. The results of the best 12 performing students with 28 marks or above (best 5) are as follows:
